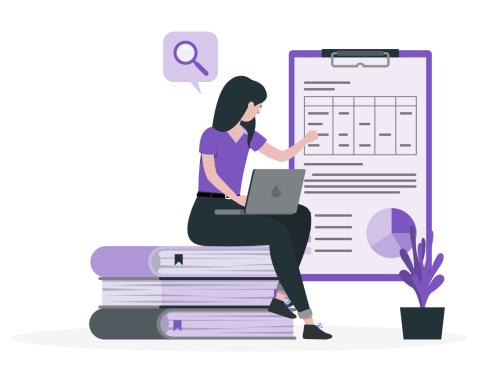

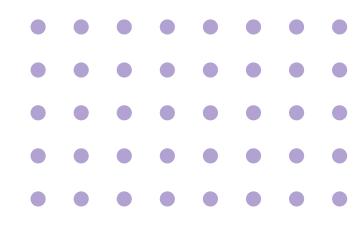

- Campbelltown is a busy hospital with a large number of births and high risk patient population. The specialists are very hands on and supportive. During the day there would be at least 3 Staff Specialists covering different areas within O&G including BU, ward, emergency/ on call/ OT, EPAS and FMAU. After hours the VMOs/ staff specialists will attend handover and ward rounds. They are very approachable and supportive.
- During the SRMO and unaccredited year the junior doctor would rotate through all areas including ANC, Gynae clinics, EPAS and FMAU (where ultrasound skills may be developed), caesarean lists, birthing unit, on call Gynae Reg (learn how to do D&Cs, marsupialisations).
- Depending on how keen the SRMO or unaccredited registrar is and whether they want to attain DRANZCOG they may be able to assist or attend gynae lists.
- Involvement in research and teaching of medical students from WSU as well as presenting in M&M and QA meetings (including CTG, Caesarean section and IOL meetings).
- Interview practice for applying to college provided by consultants and advanced trainees.
- Duration of the 12 months is spent at Campbelltown

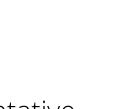

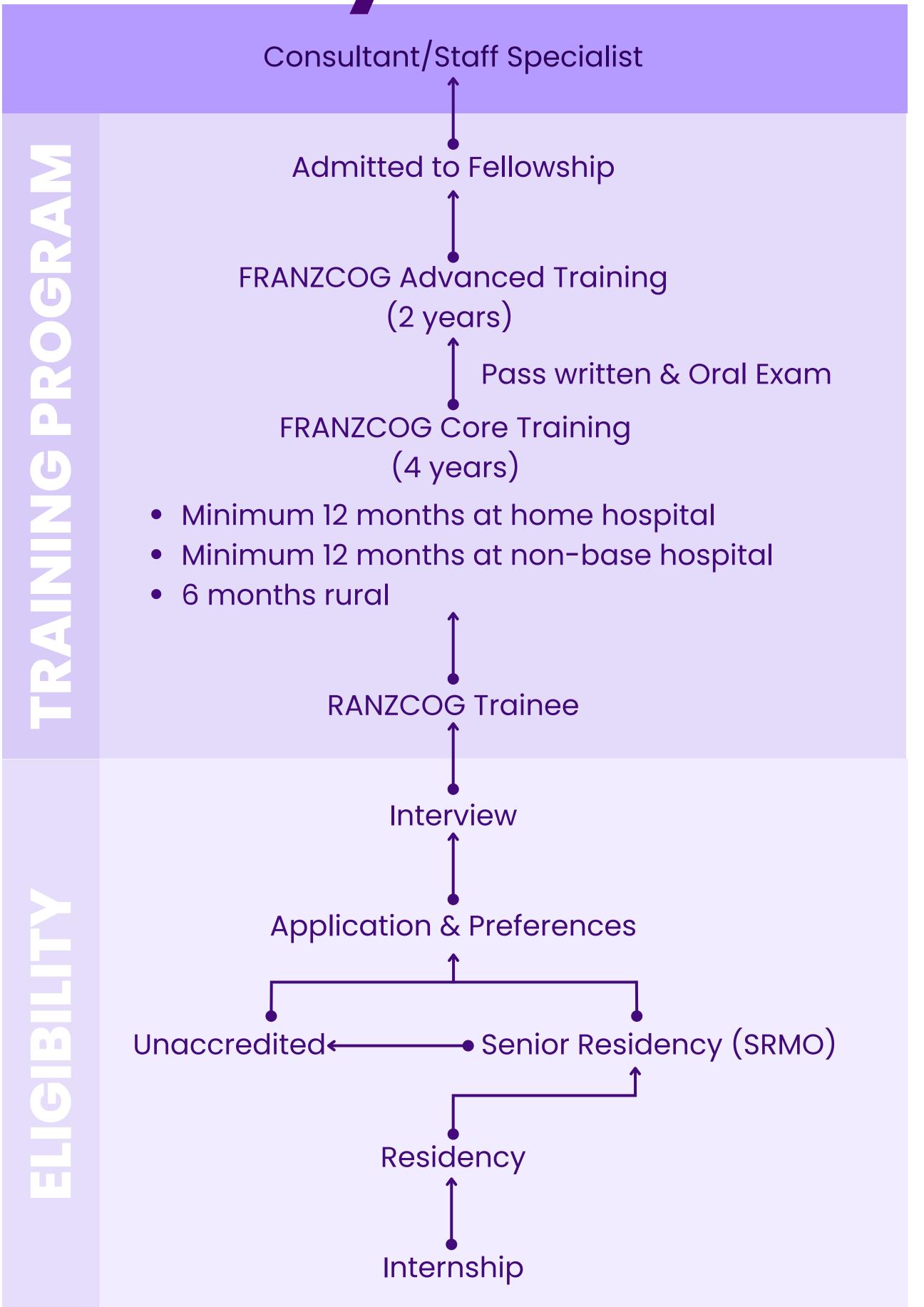

SRMO Positions and FRANZCOG <u>Application</u>

- Clinical experience has become one of the most heavily weighted components of the CV (18/59)
- SRMO jobs are therefore an excellent way to build this aspect of your application
- Likewise, dedicating yourself to a single health network for 12 months is a way to seek out mentors and develop the references needed for entry

Phase 1 vs. Phase 2 Training Positions

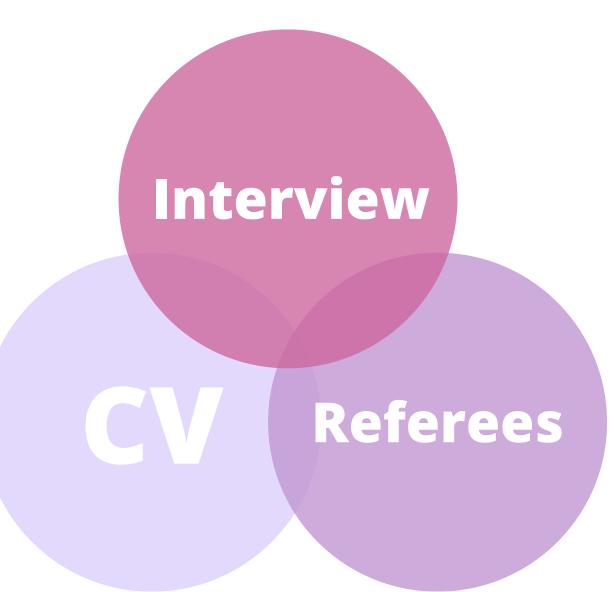
- Positions are divided into phase 1 and phase 2, depending on the location of the training position.
- Note if offered a phase 1 position, applicants will not be considered for a phase 2 position
- Phase 1: Regional Integrated
 Training program (RITP) or
 Integrated Training Program (ITP)
- Phase 2: Applicants preference up to 3 of the remaining Australian states/territories

Australia had **207 applicants, of which 88 were offered a training position for the 2022 Training Year**

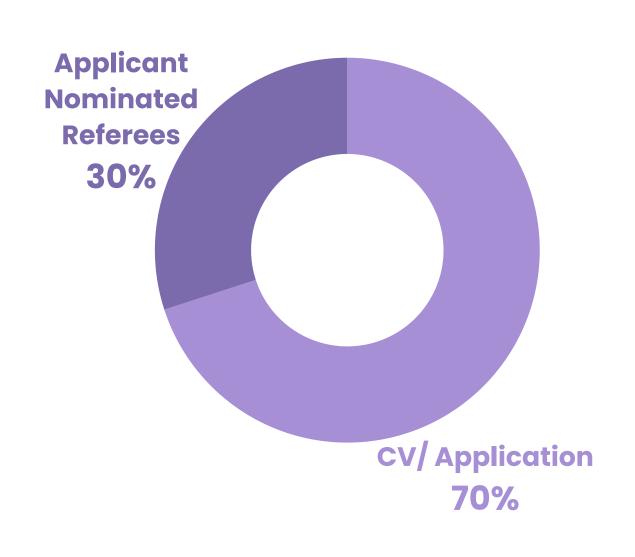

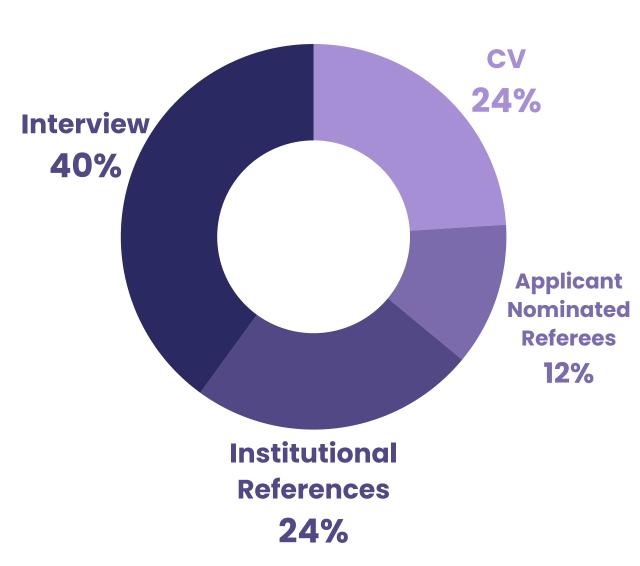

Prevocational Pathway (PVP).

In 2019, RANZCOG added the Prevocational Pathway (PVP) to the CV scoring criteria, and completion of this brings with it 6 CV points.

- To apply for the PVP, you must first complete the Certificate of Women's Health
- The Certificate of Women's Health (CWH) involves:
 - Completion of workshops (on Foetal Surveillance, Neonatal Resuscitation and Basic Obstetrics Skills)
 - Completion of a logbook (which requires O&G clinical experience, no longer time stipulations)
 - CWH Examination (MCQ exam)
- Completing the PVP then involves having completed a number of O&G workshops and online modules.

What can you do to get started?

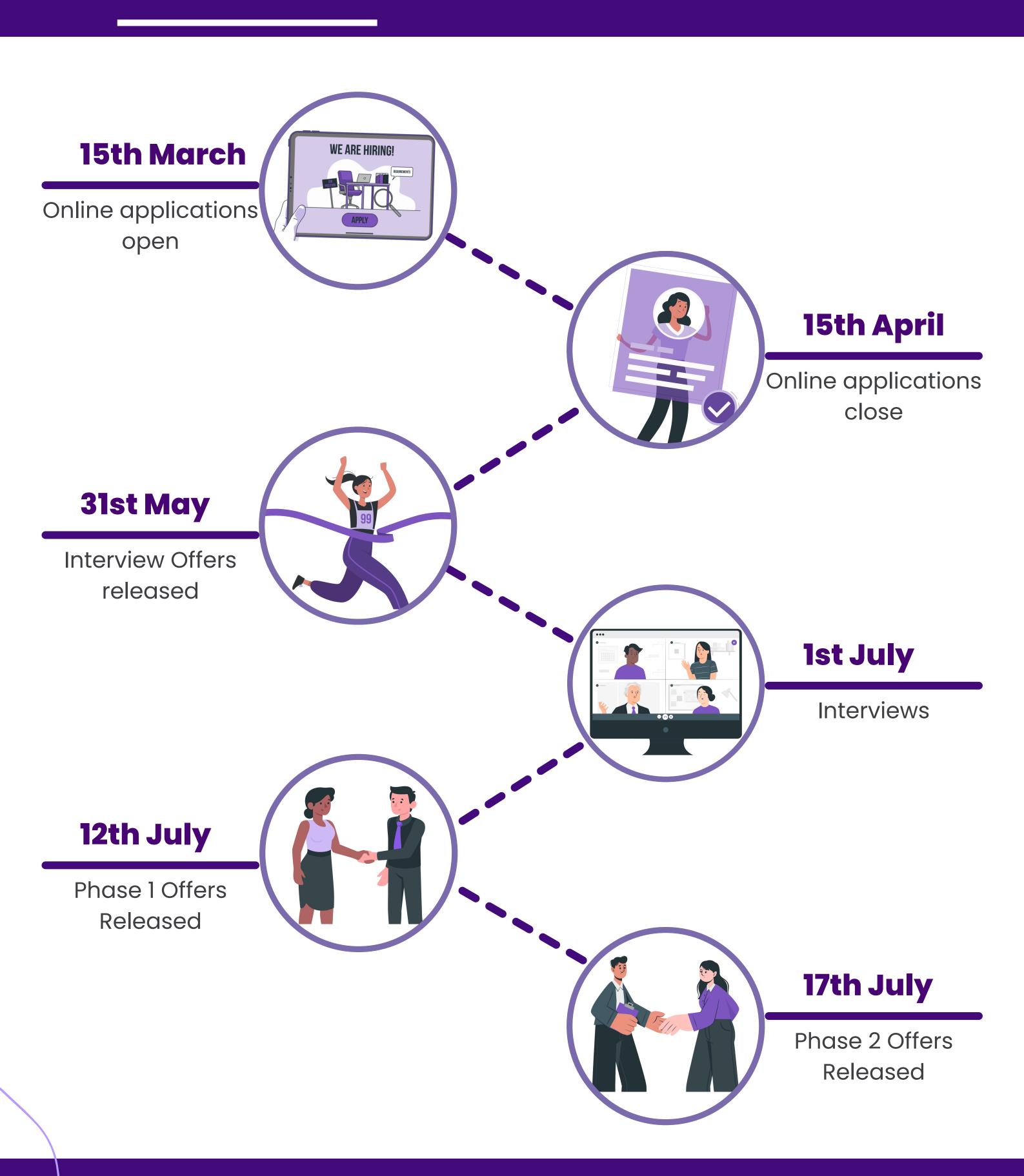
- 1. Register for approved workshops
 - Normally held only 1-2 times throughout the year.
- 2. Apply for the Certificate of Women's Health (CWH) with an approved supervisor through your current hospital
